Eg. OVIC TA/LA (TA Q1+4, Topex 38% Benzo, MT, admin by LJ RDH), (LA - 2 carps Lido 2% w epi, Q1 (PSA, MSA, ASA), Q4 (IA, BI), admin by Dr. Tooth, ct tol well, LA- POIG.
